VENDOR APPLICATION & INFORMATION (Applications due July 15th)

At the 2009 Bark For Life, vendors have an opportunity to help raise money for the American Cancer Society's mission.

Campsites will be provided to the following in preferential order:

- Bark For Life teams (6-8 dogs) doing onsite fundraising
- Relay For Life teams from nearby events who are fundraising for their Relay
- Vendors who have goods and services to provide to the “dog” and/or “cancer fighting” communities.

NEARBY RELAY TEAMS

Teams from other events who wish to continue their fundraising efforts for their event may commit to a campsite at the Bark For Life. These teams have the option to designate their funds raised to their “home” Relay or to the Bark For Life.

VENDORS

For-profit vendors may bring goods and services to sell at Bark For Life. Vendors pay a \$100 campsite fee and a minimum of 20% of their sales must be donated to the Bark For Life.

LOGISTICS INFORMATION

- Campsites are a minimum of 10 feet x 15 feet with 10 feet as the “storefront.” Final sizes will be determined closer to the event.
- Pop up/EZ Up tents are not provided and vendors are encouraged to bring their own.
- Vendors and teams must be set-up and ready to go at 7:30am on Saturday, July 25th.
- Power is not available and generators are not permitted.
- Tables, chairs and all supplies must be supplied by the vendor or team.
- Fundraising teams and Vendors will be assigned a campsite at random.
